Dear Partners and Friends of CMC,

With your prayers, participation and financial support and by God's grace the year 2012 has proved to be another productive year for CMC based on the following:

- a) We have registered an **average salvation response rate of 91%** this year which resulted to the salvation of **83,464 people** in our crusade in the Bicol region and Northern Luzon. This is our record highest. Before this, the highest recorded rate was in 2010 when we registered a response rate of 87% in our crusade in Samar. Our average response rate over the last seven years is 78%.
- b) We have planted **80 new churches in our crusades** this year. This is another record figure. Our highest figure in the past was in Cebu when we reported 100 church plants but this count was made over a 2 year period. This brings the total number of churches planted as a direct result of the crusade over the last seven years to 347.
- c) **Another 313 churches was planted by our CMC networks** this year, a rate of nearly 1 church plant per day. This brings the total number of churches planted through our CMC networks to 1735 since we formally started our movement last Nov 2006.
- d) With a **collective total of 2082 churches planted in both our crusades and through our CMC networks** (2007-2012), we are getting closer to our goal of planting a church in each of the remaining 23,000 villages in the Philippines that do not have a single evangelical church.

We also have high expectations for 2013 as we embark on the following:

- a) We will continue our crusade saturation in the rest of the Bicol region. We expect the same or even a greater harvest because of the snowball effect of saturation evangelism as news of the crusade success precedes our coming to the new area.
- b) We will introduce a church planting training program that we developed in response to the clamor for a simple, transferrable and sustainable church planting method from our CMC members. We are hopeful that this simple program will finally initiate a church multiplication movement – not just addition - in the Philippines and in Asia.
- c) We will bring 2 crusade teams to Cambodia and 1 crusade team to Myanmar to help jumpstart the church planting movement in these nations. These team will work with local Pastors who are part of our CMC networks to do ministries in villages for the purpose of church planting.
- d) We will continue to strengthen our partnership with E3 (Evangelize, Equip, Establish), LAMP (Love Asia Missions Partners), Bible League, One Hope, MBM (Micro Business Mentors), Aglow International and other likeminded organizations who share the same passion and vision for soul winning, church planting and community transformation.

In closing, I would like to thank you once more for your participation and support but above all let us thank God for all that He has done and for all that He will continue to do through us. To God be all the Glory!

Annual Report for CY 2012-CMC Philippines and Asia Full Report to Partners and Friends

As we close another year of Partnership with you, let me once more report to you what God has done in the Philippines and in Asia as we move closer in realizing our vision of planting “A Church in Every Community” and achieving our goals of:

- a) Presenting the Lordship of Christ to Everyone
- b) Planting a Church within walking distance of every Believer, and
- c) Bringing revival to Churches, Leaders and Believers

Crusade Evangelism

Having done all of the islands in the Visayas region, all 10 teams who came to the Philippines this year went to Luzon. Eight came to the region of Bicol in Southern Luzon, while 2 went to Northern Luzon.

This year we have ministered to a total crowd of 91,227 in schools, hospitals, jails, house to house evangelism and in our nightly crusade. From this crowd, 83,464 responded to the altar call for salvation for a response rate of 91%. This is a record high since our highest response before this year was only 87% during our crusade in Samar in 2010.

We also planted a collective total of 80 churches from these 10 crusades, another record high. Although we reported a total of 100 church plants in our Cebu crusade last 2007-2008, this count was made over a 2-year period.

This great harvest is something unusual considering that Bicol is one of the most religious – if not the most religious region in Luzon. This region has also one of the least number of Evangelical Christians with the region’s average at 4%. One province, Albay, even has less than 1% Christians (0.65% as of 2012, based on a survey made by Albay Province Ministerial Association).

Because of the result of the crusade and the momentum that the crusade has generated, we believe that the spiritual landscape in this region will change for the better within the next few years.

We also continue to see God’s power at work during the crusade as healings and miracles were experienced by the people, both Believers and Unbelievers, day after day. One notable healing involves a Pastor who was also a Bible School Administrator. He was healed of cancer after a crusade team prayed for him. The cancer was on its terminal stage and the Pastor was given by the Doctor only 3 months to live. When the power of God came upon him during prayer, he removed his oxygen hose, got up from his wheelchair and started walking around. Everyone was in tears when they saw this miracle. After a few weeks, he was able to function normally and was able to travel and drive around in his car. Many other similar miracles took place.

Our crusade has continued to be cost effective. Based on the total cost that we have spent this year to reach out to the people that we have ministered, the cost of saving one soul still remains within the \$1 range at \$1.26 per soul. This was \$1.19 per soul last year.

From above table, **39 new CMC networks were added this year** bringing our total networks all over the Philippines to 332. We now have CMC presence in 66% of the provinces in the Philippines.

A total of **313 new churches were also planted this year** bringing the total number of churches planted by our CMC Networks to 1735 since we started this movement last November 2006.

With 313 churches planted, the rate that we are planting churches this year is nearly one church per day. Yet the potential to plant more churches is there since our membership is now 4980 strong.

In our consultation meetings with CMC leaders, the following reasons were advanced why the pace of church planting is slow.

1. **Lack of ownership** of the CMC vision. Because of this, personal or church concerns have priority over church planting and they did not have time to plant a new church.
2. For those who have attempted to plant churches, **the church planting method they used were either complicated or expensive**. They were only successful in planting one or 2 churches while some did not even successfully plant a church.
3. Many want to plant churches but **they do not know how and they want to be trained**.

In response to above concerns, we have decided to develop a simple, transferrable and sustainable church planting training program. We were able to do this and late this year we introduced a simple program to our key leaders in the Philippines. We also trained them to become Facilitators and Trainers of the program.

Essentially the program has 4 modules and if implemented will harness the whole church membership to become Soul Winners, Bible Study Leaders, Disciplers/Trainers and Church Planters. The program is also designed to finally help initiate a church multiplication movement.

The modules are as follows:

Module 1 : Every Believer a Soul Winner

Module 2: Every Soul Winner a Bible Study Leader

Module 3. Every Bible Study Leader a Trainer / Discippler

Module 4: Every Bible Study a Potential Church

Church Planting training will be our main focus next year. The CMC Regional and Provincial Coordinators that we have trained this year will in turn train the Network leaders in their respective areas. The network leaders will then filter down the training to Pastors and churches who are part of their networks.

CMC Asia

This year we have continued to consolidate our CMC movement in Asia. Advisory councils have been set up in Indonesia, Vietnam and Thailand, while CMC networks are now in place in Malaysia, Burma and Cambodia.

We have also identified some platforms projects that can help in our church planting effort. Community water wells, public toilets and medical missions were identified as platforms that can help the Pastors in Cambodia gain entry in villages to evangelize and plant churches. In response to these needs, we have put up 5 water wells and 1 public toilet in 6 target villages and they now have ongoing bible studies in these villages in Cambodia.

We are hoping to jumpstart our CMC church planting movement in Cambodia and Myanmar in 2013 by bringing in evangelistic teams to work with local Pastors and churches to plant churches in villages that do not have a church. We have seen this model working in the Visayas region in the Philippines. In areas where we have done crusade evangelism, the participating Pastors who eventually became part of CMC networks were the ones planting more churches (in addition to the churches that were planted as a direct result of the crusade) compared to other regions mainly because of their positive experience during the crusade.

We are also planning to bring Medical teams mainly in Cambodia and in nations where these are applicable, we will continue with our water well and public toilet projects next year.

Partnership with other Organizations

We should mention that other organizations who have partnered with us have also made significant contributions to CMC's goals. These include the following:

1. **E3 (Evangelize, Equip, Establish)** - E3 has been a long time partner with CMC. They have helped us with materials and ideas (evangecube, I am Second) and we have also helped them set up Pastors Covenant Networks in nations where they have some presence. The Church Planting training that we just developed (discussed above) is heavily influenced by E3. We have also helped E3 set up Pastors Covenant Networks in India. In 9 month's time after our visit, over 300 churches were planted by one covenant Pastors group in one region in India.
2. **Aglow International** - They have also been our long time partner in evangelism, church planting and community transformation. This year, they sent a large team to help our crusade evangelism in Bicol and next year, Aglow will be sending evangelistic teams to the Philippines, Cambodia and Myanmar.
3. **Bible League** - They have supplied our needs for bibles at a subsidized cost (about \$0.63 per New Testament Bibles. Note: This was only \$0.38 / piece the previous years). This year they supplied us with 12,990 bibles for our crusades and over 2,000 bibles for the church planting efforts of our CMC networks.
4. **One Hope** - This group used to be called the Book of Hope. They have supplied us with 72,600 books that we distributed to children and teenagers during our school ministry and in our day-after bible study follow up. They have also made available their books to our CMC networks to help the Pastors in their evangelistic and church planting works.
5. **MBM (Micro Business Mentors)** - This group wants to see community transformation by training, mentoring and granting interest-free loans to the poorest of the poor in a community. They have extended loans to 31 individuals in Cebu and although some challenges in loans payments have been experienced, MBM have indirectly contributed to the planting of 2 churches in Cebu.
6. **LAMP (Love Asia Missions Partner)** - When we started our works in Asia, LAMP has been our major partner. They helped us with promotion and development and helped us connect with key leaders in Asia who are now part of CMC. LAMP will also help bring Medical teams to work with CMC networks in these nations for the purpose of church planting.

Partnership Opportunities

As previously mentioned, the year 2013 is very promising. With God's help we will continue to expand and solidify our works in Asia. We also expect many souls will be added to God's Kingdom and more churches to be planted in the Philippines as the CMC church planting training will be implemented.

Along with this expansion and growth, we also expect an increase in financial needs. Right now we have a very narrow financial base with only a handful of people supporting us financially. In order to do all that we have committed to do, we need more finances to come in and more people to support us. We invite you to be an active participant of what God is doing through CMC with your financial contributions and prayers.

The money that you will give will go to the following expense:

1. **Bibles** – In addition to the bibles that we give during the crusade (which is paid for by the crusade budget), we are supplying our networks with bibles for the new believers who will form part of the new churches that they will be planting as they work together to evangelize and plant churches.

Your money can help purchase the following:

\$50 = 80 pcs of New Testament Bibles

\$100 = 160 pcs

\$500 = 800 pcs

\$1000 = 1600 pcs

2. **Roofing Subsidy** - As new churches are planted by the networks, we want to be part of their collective effort by providing a roofing subsidy of \$75 per new church. Your money can help us subsidize roofing as follows:

\$75 = 1 church

\$150 = 2 churches

\$300 = 4 churches

\$900 = 12 churches

3. **Water Well and Public Toilets.** The cost of these platform projects are as follows:

\$200 = 1 water pump in Cambodia

\$250 = 1 public toilet in Cambodia

4. **Travelling Expenses.** Everyone who is involved with CMC is working on a voluntary basis but as much as we can, we would like to subsidize the travelling expenses of our national, regional and provincial leaders as they go around doing works for CMC. We see this cost increasing next year as we will take more trips to Asia to do more promotion, development and mentoring work. We also see this cost increasing in the Philippines as our national, regional and provincial leaders will take more trips to conduct church planting trainings and do mentoring works after the training.

Your contribution will help pay for the cost of the following trips:

1 week Asia Trip = \$ 2000

1 Phil. Provincial training trip = \$ 100
